Scheduling your appointments

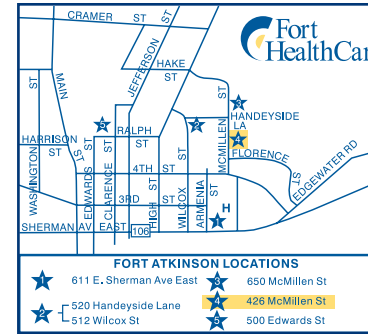

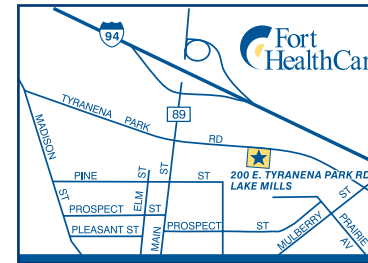

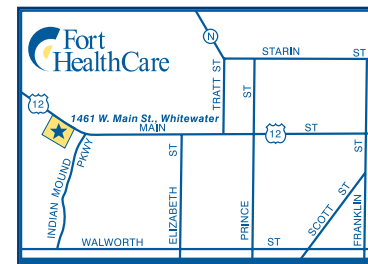

Athletic Training

Certified athletic trainers are healthcare professionals specialized in prevention, evaluation and rehabilitation of sports injuries. Athletic trainers administer emergency care for acute sports injuries and rehabilitate people with chronic sports injuries.

Occupational Therapy

Occupational therapists are specially trained in evaluation and treatment of musculoskeletal, neuromuscular, cognitive and perceptual disorders. Occupational therapists will customize a treatment plan to improve an individual's ability to carry out their activities of daily living.

Physical Therapy

Physical therapists are specially trained in evaluation and treatment of musculoskeletal and neuromuscular problems. These problems affect one's ability to move and function as well as they can in their daily lives. Through consultation, treatment and education, physical therapy restores health, improves function and alleviates pain.
