Dear Potential Volunteer,

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at Fort HealthCare. We are always looking for more volunteers!

If you decide you would like to volunteer for Fort HealthCare, please complete the application and mail it back to me by postal or e-mail. I will then give you a call to set up an appointment for your interview and orientation. This appointment will take about 60-90 minutes.

Please be aware that we do require a 50-hour (annual) commitment for adults, a 30 hour commitment for students, and a health screening. The health screening includes a QuantiFERON® TB test, <u>flu vaccine</u> (if you have not already received one for the season), blood titers to test for your immunity to measles, mumps, rubella and varicella, and possibly vaccinations if the blood work shows that they are needed. (There is no charge to you for the tests or vaccinations.) In addition, (per the state of Wisconsin) a criminal and caregiver background check must be completed on all health care employees and volunteers.

Our volunteers find their work here to be fun, challenging and personally satisfying. I look forward to meeting you and getting you started as a volunteer in our health care system. Please feel free to give me a call at 920-568-5276 if you have any questions about the enclosed materials.
