For community members who have chronic health conditions and cannot afford this life-saving alert system, the funds raised will allow the Partners CareLine Program to provide FREE or reduced rates to qualifying clients. Funds will also be used to support several healthcare scholarships for students and professionals in the community. We want to ensure that the people entering the healthcare field have resources available to pay for their education.
